

# PARTNER REPLICATION SYSTEM

## OVERVIEW

For all series of Xoasis Network Prodigy VoIP solutions, you may use the **Partner Replication System** manager to synchronize system settings between multiple units. Replication will occur for the following settings: phone/extension user accounts, dial plans, call groups, and conference settings. Replication will not occur for outbound calling patterns and PSTN card configurations that are unit specific settings.

To configure Partner Replication please open the **VoIP Connection Manager**, add a new connection for each of the Xoasis units you plan to configure for replication. Once the connections are added, you will see a red hand below the Partner Replication setting; click the red hand to enable Partner Replication between the current unit and the remote unit. You will need to enable Partner Replication on the remote unit as well.


Partner replication will occur in real-time; additions added on any of the replicated units will be passed to other units enabled for replication. Replicated changes will occur to partner units within one minute of additions, changes, or deletions.

## EXAMPLE

In the example below, Partner Replication is enabled between the remote unit "falcon2" but not enabled on the connection to "proxim":
